DAY 1: ARUSHA - LAKE MANYARA

The park is also home to abundant hippos and playful baboons, adding to the vibrant tapestry of wildlife.

As the day draws to a close, we'll ascend to the top of the Great Rift Valley, where our accommodation awaits. Imagine gazing out over Lake Manyara as the sun sets, painting the sky with breath-taking hues. You'll have a range of overnight options to choose from, including the luxurious Lake Manyara Tree Lodge, Lake Manyara Serena, E Unoto Retreat, Kirurumu Tented Camp, Lake Manyara Hotel, or Panorama Camp. Rest assured, whichever option you choose, you'll be treated to exceptional service and the opportunity to immerse yourself in the tranquil beauty of the surroundings.

DAY 2: SIX HOURS IN NGORONGORO CENTER

Prepare for an extraordinary day filled with the possibility of encountering the renowned "Big Five" in one location: lion, rhino, elephant, buffalo, and leopard. Our destination is the magnificent Ngorongoro Conservation Area, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a true natural wonder.

The Ngorongoro Crater, often referred to as the "Eighth Wonder of the World," is the centrepiece of this extraordinary region. It is the largest unbroken caldera in the world, spanning approximately 260 square kilometres and plunging 610 meters deep. This microcosm of East African scenery and wildlife is a sight to behold.



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Our experienced guide will navigate the crater's diverse ecosystems, leading us to prime locations where the "Big Five" are frequently spotted. Keep your cameras ready to capture the majesty of a lioness with her cubs, the imposing presence of a rhinoceros, the gentle grace of elephants, the sturdy herds of buffalo, and if luck is on our side, the elusive leopard gracefully manoeuvring through the vegetation.

During our exploration, we'll pause for a delightful picnic lunch at the crater floor, surrounded by breathtaking views and the rich tapestry of wildlife. It's a truly unforgettable experience, immersing yourself in the heart of this natural sanctuary.

As the afternoon draws to a close, we'll begin our journey back to Arusha, filled with awe-inspiring memories of the incredible wildlife encounters we've had.
